

Creating and Maintaining a Digital Portfolio

A **Digital Portfolio** is a collection of the artwork you have created. Instead of it being held in a large folder in the classroom, it is kept in a digital format on your computer. Your D.P. will include photographs and short written reflections. You will be given a formative assessment (20 %) every two weeks and for your midterm and final, you will be asked to give a written review of your portfolio that will count towards a summative assessment (80%).

Requirements:

- Your D.P. must be updated at least every two weeks
- All finished work must be documented in your D.P., in addition, you may include work that is almost finished or work that you feel was more of an experimentation than a finished artwork (ex. sketchbook studies, technical practices).

Learning Goals:

"I can embrace artistic challenges both personal and of the art world, and develop a focus that allows me to persevere through challenges and complete my ideas and / or a personal body of work." (Studio Habits of Mind, *Engage & Persist*)

"I can create an artwork / body of work that is a result of learning from exploration and learning from past experiences (successes & mistakes)." (Studio Habits of Mind, *Stretch & Explore*)

"I can think about my artwork and explain it to another person." (Studio Habits of Mind, *Reflect*)

Format:

You will use Google Presentation or Google Sites.

With each entry, you need to include:

- A clear photo of your work that is cropped and straight.
- The title
- The date of your entry
- What you used to make your work
- A reflective statement that includes answers to *all of the following*:

1. What was your Personal Learning Goal? How did you meet this goal and / or what do you need to do to have more growth with this goal?
2. What was your intent in making this? What did you want your viewers to experience, feel, see, etc?
3. Does this work fit into a larger body of work? Are you planning to do more with this idea? How so?
4. What techniques did you use for this project? How do you think it enhanced your work? What changes or additions can you make?
