Value

I can choose from various techniques to create value and can use it purposefully, to convey form, in a personal work of art.

Space

I can use a variety of methods to convey a realistic sense of space and do so purposefully, in personal work of art.

Line

I can determine when to use various types of line, purposefully in a personal work of art.

I can purposefully use a variety of line weight to convey form.

I can purposefully vary my line to express emotion.

Color

I can mix a variety of colors in order to create a personal color palette and use it purposefully in a personal work of art.

I can mix a value range of colors and use them to convey a realistic sense of space and form in a personal work of art.

Form

I can purposefully create 3-D forms in a variety of materials and sizes.

I can create artwork in various degrees of 3-D form (low relief, high relief)

I can purposefully convey 3-D form in a 2-D work of art.

Texture

I can use texture (real or implied) purposefully in a personal work of art.

Create: Generate and conceptualize artistic ideas and work

Create: Organize and develop artistic ideas and work

I can experiment with a variety of processes and materials.

Create: Refine and complete artistic work

I can engage in self reflection based on a set of criteria or after a critique and make revisions on my art work in progress.
